The Summer Slide

Have you heard of the “summer slide”? Unfortunately, it’s not the fun kind of slide you’ll find at a water park or playground. This slide is different. It’s a slide that no mom wants her child to ride.

What Is the Summer Slide

The summer slide is a decline in reading ability and other academic skills that can occur over the summer months when school isn’t in session.

Numerous studies show that kids who don’t read during summer vacation actually slip in reading ability by the time autumn rolls around.

But as parents, we don’t need studies to tell us this, do we? It’s evident in all sorts of situations. For example, if your child plays the violin but stops practicing for three months, his skills will decline more than the skills of a child who continued to practice and play the violin over the summer, right? So what can we do to avoid this common problem?

How to Prevent the Summer Slide

Here’s the secret to preventing the summer slide: Keep learning all summer long. (Now, don’t panic, I’m not talking about year-round schooling, although for some homeschool families, year-round schooling may be a good solution.)

I’m talking about consciously striving to provide learning opportunities throughout the summer to keep kids’ academic skills sharp. Check out the infographic below for a big list of ideas to help you put an end to the summer slide!

El Tobogán de Verano

¿Has oído hablar de la "diapositiva de verano"? Desafortunadamente, no es el tipo de tobogán divertido que encontrarás en un parque acuático o parque infantil. Esta diapositiva es diferente. Es un tobogán que ninguna madre quiere que su hijo monte.

¿Qué es el tobogán de Verano?

La diapositiva de verano es una disminución en la capacidad de lectura y otras habilidades académicas que pueden ocurrir durante los meses de verano cuando la escuela no está en sesión.

Numerosos estudios muestran que los niños que no leen durante las vacaciones de verano en realidad pierden la capacidad de lectura para cuando llega el otoño.

Pero como padres, no necesitamos estudios para decirnos esto, ¿verdad? Es evidente en todo tipo de situaciones. Por ejemplo, si su hijo toca el violín pero deja de practicar durante tres meses, sus habilidades disminuirán más que las de un niño que continuó practicando y tocando el violín durante el verano, ¿verdad?

Entonces, ¿qué podemos hacer para evitar este problema común?

Cómo prevenir el tobogán de Verano

Aquí está el secreto para evitar la caída del verano: sigue aprendiendo todo el verano. (Ahora, no se asuste, no estoy hablando de la educación durante todo el año, aunque para algunas familias de educación en el hogar, la educación durante todo el año puede ser una buena solución).

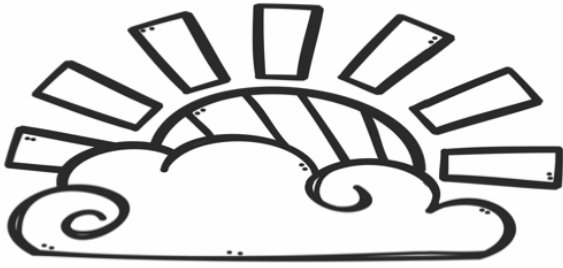

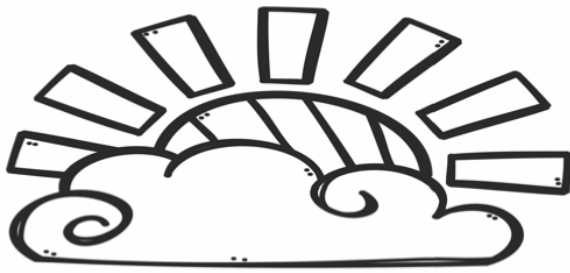
